## Rate includes:

Exclusive use of a 5 bedroom, 5 bathroom rustic farmhouse in the Greater Kruger National Park, on a self-catering basis.  
Wifi, air-conditioned rooms, swimming pool and housekeeping once daily.

## Rate excludes:

- Mandatory housekeeping charge: R150 per reservation
- Reserve Entry fee: payable on arrival at the Control gate: R150 per vehicle
- Daily Conservation fee: payable on arrival at the Control gate: R100 pp (SADC members), valid for 7 days
- Compensation for any breakages or damages during your stay
- Transfers, if not driving yourself
- Game drives (enquire about availability and rate)

## Child policy:

Camp David is situated in a Big 5 reserve where wild animals roam freely. The property is unfenced, giving dangerous animals free roam right up to the house, many times through the camp itself.

We welcome children of all ages, however, we would suggest not bringing children younger than 8 years.

Children must be supervised at ALL times

## Reservation policy:

50% deposit to secure your booking

50% balance payable 7 days before arrival

100% of booking value payable if booked less than 7 days before arrival

## Rates and Information

### Cancellation policy:

Cancellation 7 days or less before arrival - 50% of the total value of the booking will be refunded.  
Should the full amount not have been received yet, the deposit paid will be withheld.

### Check in time, departure time and directions:

- Check in is from 15h00, check out before 11h00
- Entry onto the reserve is via the Balule Parsons Control Gate on the R40 between Hoedspruit and Phalaborwa.
- Camp David is situated 12km from the Control Gate. Travel between the Control Gate and house will take between 30 and 40 minutes. The road is uneven gravel and a speed limit of 30km/h is applicable on all roads inside the Reserve. Vehicles with a higher clearance are highly recommended, but not essential.
- Directions to the lodge will be sent to you via email or Whatsapp before your arrival date, or can be found on our website <https://morulethaba.wixsite.com/campdavid>
- You will require a QR code which you must present to the gate guard to scan on arrival. Please log onto our website: <https://morulethaba.wixsite.com/campdavid> and complete the form on the "Directions and Info" tab. Your QR code will be sent to you via Whatsapp on the number supplied.
- Gate times are restricted according to season, and guests may enter and exit through the control gate between 05h00 and 17h00. Plan your journey to make time for stops and sightseeing, ensuring you reach the Reserve gate before 17h00 on the day of your arrival. No late entry to the Reserve will be permitted. Any additional costs incurred due to late arrival will be for your own account.

### General Info and Indemnity

- Game drives can only be conducted by registered guides. Camp David relies on nearby lodges to supply this service to our guests at an additional charge. Please enquire about availability and price in advance.
- By entering onto and using the facilities at Camp David Parsons 58, situated in Parsons Nature Reserve, Hoedspruit, you and your party acknowledge that you are fully aware of the inherent danger that wild animals may pose, and that you enter onto and use the amenities and property entirely at own risk.
